Nutrition and Physical Fitness

Healthy Eating and Food Demonstration

Participants will learn about the various factors that affect the way we eat. Participants learn strategies that they can use to eat healthier through a food demonstration.

Creating a Weekly Family Menu

Parents will learn strategies to plan a weekly family menu that is healthy, in order to ensure proper nutritional consumption for the family.

Eating Healthy on a Budget

Parents will learn how to shop for healthier seasonal food products and preventing food waste, while remaining budget friendly.

The Importance of Family Physical Fitness

Parents will learn about the benefits of physical fitness on one's health while demonstrating activities that they can do at home with their families in order to increase physical fitness.

Visual Arts

Art is the expression of a culture in different ways with an aesthetic and communicative purpose.

Family Tree

In this workshop participants discussed the importance of family communication and create a project that includes the representation of their immediate family.

Olinala Jewelry Boxes

This project is based on the folk art tradition of creating pieces with lacquer and intricate geometric and organic designs. Participants will learn more about the origins of this art practice which comes from the state of Guerrero in Mexico while decorating a cardboard jewelry box with traditional designs.

Aluminum Nichos

Based on the ancient practice of embossing in Pre-Hispanic and European traditions, participants will emboss a piece of work on aluminum using different tools and techniques to create a *Nicho*. A presentation on the origins and modern practice of this art form is included.

Bark Paper paintings

Bark paper was used in indigenous cultures to create *codices*, books that recorded their history and traditions. In modern folk art, this paper is used as a canvas to create beautiful colorful paintings of flora and fauna. Participants will create their own piece on bark paper.

Party Décor

Tissue paper flowers and tissue paper banners are two of the most popular forms of decoration for celebrations in Mexico. Participants will learn how to create different versions of each and take-home examples that can be recreated with their families.

Folk Art Inspired Picture Frames

The vast diversity that exists in Mexican folk art is presented to participants and then used as inspiration to create their own designs to be painted on to a picture frame.

Talavera Vases

Participants will receive a medium sized papier-mache vase to be decorated with Talavera designs in cobalt blue paint.

Tin Milagro Magnets

Using different embossing techniques, participants will create magnets out of aluminum sheets.

Spring / Summer - March to June

Felt Door Hangers

Door hangers are made using felt to create flowers and butterflies to be placed on decorative rope.

Floral Wreaths

Using different floral accents, these crowns are created to be displayed as the centerpiece to the front door of your home.

Fall / September - Mid November

Fall Themed table Centerpieces

This session focuses on the history and importance of this celebration in our country. To accompany the presentation, a center piece for your dining table is created.
